

Amendment Proposals:

I. Constitutional amendment relieving the Board of Directors for the responsibility of receiving grievances and benevolent donation requests and also relieving them for follow up on grievances and benevolent requests.

II. Constitutional amendment to allow Executive Board and Board of Director members to serve as either a committee member or committee chairman in the event that the position is vacant and there are no other qualified members willing to serve in that capacity. This would also give voting power to these Executive Board or Board of Director members when serving in that capacity.

III. Constitutional amendment allowing for the implementation of a Member Advisory Board. Representatives of the board will be from the following areas:

The Member Advisory Board would be elected by their shift and serve terms as does the Executive Board and Board of Directors. The purpose of the Member Advisory Board will be:

- a. Attend all General Assembly Meetings;
- b. Report to their respective shifts all matters discussed in the general assembly meeting and report any actions proposed by the Executive Board or Board of Directors;
- c. Act as liaison between their co-workers and the Executive Board reporting all concerns of their co-workers to the Executive Board;
- d. Recruit new members and retain existing members;
- e. Report any change in their assignment or shift to the President;
- f. Any other duty that may be approved by a majority of the Executive Board or a majority of the entire general membership
